5. What are the hallmarks of cancer? **(6 marks)**

**Give Reasons**

**(2 marks for each)**

1. Occurrence of mucoepidermoid carcinoma centrally within jaw.
2. Fracture of teeth during extraction in cases of Paget's disease.
3. Osteomyelitis occurs in irradiated jaws.
4. Sialolith most commonly affects submandibular gland duct.
5. High recurrence rate of Prognoma.

6. Granular cell ameloblastoma has the worst prognosis than the other types of ameloblastomas.
7. The wall of developmental branchial cleft cyst contains lymphoid tissue.
8. The patient's tooth feels pain on percussion and elongated in its socket in acute periodontitis.
